3. This is an application for early hearing.
4. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.
5. The application is disposed of.

CRL.M.(BAIL) 455/2024

6. This is an application under Section 389 CrPC seeking suspension of sentence during the pendency of the criminal revision petition.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been found guilty for the offences under Sections 279/304A IPC and has been sentenced to undergo imprisonment of one year. He submits that out of the said period, the petitioner has already undergone almost 02 months and 05 days in custody. He further submits that the petitioner is 70 years old senior citizen and has faced the agony of trial since the year 1997.



8. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, as well as, regard being had to the sentence awarded to the petitioner is only for a period of one year and he has already undergone sentence of 02 months and 05 days, the sentence of the appellant is suspended during the pendency of the present petition subject to his furnishing a Personal Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- and one Surety Bond of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/CMM/Duty Magistrate, further subject to the following conditions:-

- a) Petitioner shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing.
- b) Petitioner shall provide his mobile number to the IO concerned which shall be kept in working condition at all times and he shall not change the mobile number without prior intimation to the Investigating Officer concerned.
- c) Petitioner shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with the witnesses.

9. The application is disposed of.

10. The date already fixed as 16.05.2024 stands cancelled.

11. Copy of the order be forwarded to the concerned Jail Superintendent for necessary information and compliance.
