O.A. 157/2026 (against the order dated 15.04.2026 passed by the Ld. joint registrar (judicial) in IA 30773/2025 condoning delay of 86 days in filing reply to IA No. 6888/2025)

1. The present appeal has been filed under Rule 5, Chapter II of the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC), against an order dated 15.04.2026 passed by the Ld. Joint Registrar (Judicial) in IA No.30773/2025. The said order reads as under:

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for defendant no.4 that the said Reply was filed, however the same was lying under defects.

Record perused.

*In view of the contents mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and delay of 86 days in filing the Reply to I.A. NO. 6888/2025 IN CS COMM No. 237 OF 2025, On behalf of defendant no.4, HDFC Bank Limited is condoned subject to cost of Rs. 6000/- to be paid to the plaintiff. The Reply to the aforesaid IAs are taken on record. **I.A. stands disposed off.***

Let the matter be placed before Hon'ble Court for further directions on 27.04.2026, date already fixed."

2. After some hearing, the applicant seeks to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to raise appropriate pleas before the Ld. Joint Registrar (Judicial), as regards alleged non-compliance on the part of the defendant no.4 with the concerned statutory provisions, *inter alia*, Order XI Rule 13 CPC.
3. The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
