1. By way of present appeal filed under Section 173 of the M.V. Act, the appellant/driver of the offending vehicle has assailed the Award dated 08.11.2021 passed by the Tribunal in MACT No. 46/2018.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the offending vehicle was not involved in the accident.
3. A prima facie perusal of the records would show that while passing the impugned order amongst the other circumstances Tribunal has also placed reliance on mechanical inspection report of the offending vehicle.
4. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant does not have the financial capacity to deposit the amount awarded. He however

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concedes that the offending vehicle driven by the appellant was a luxury car being a *Mercedes*. The appellant shall file an affidavit of assets within two weeks from today.
