1. Mr. Manish Mohan, learned CGSC appearing for UOI hands over the Bench certain letters issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Finance and draws attention to the letter dated 04.11.2019 whereby it has been clarified that so far as the pension funds of scheme floated by the CPSE are concerned, the same are governed on the principle of Self Contributory Pension Scheme and has nothing to do with the Union of India as such. No particular or special fund is provided by Union to the CPSE on that account.

2. The said letters be filed alongwith short affidavit by Respondent/UOI.

3. Mr. Sharma appearing for respondent no.3 seeks and granted as a last and final opportunity, six weeks' time to file counter affidavit,



whereafter the right to file counter affidavit shall stand closed. It is made clear that this Court would proceed to decide the petition in case the said counter affidavit is not filed within the timeline stipulated.

4. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
5. List again on 27.09.2024.
