ORDER

1. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that since no relief has been sought against respondent no.3, it may be deleted from the array of respondents.

II) Issue an appropriate writ direction and order in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation (Annexed herein as P-7 to P-10) of the petitioner and allow him to get the amount deposited before the respondent with compensation.

III) Issue an appropriate writ direction and order to the respondents to provide compensation with regard to the harassment and loss suffered by the petitioner due to the act of the respondent/ respondents.”

4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.1/RBI accepts notice. Mr. Abhishek Khanna, learned Senior Panel Counsel for UOI who is present in the Court is requested to accept notice. Accordingly, he accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/UOI.
6. Let counter-affidavits be filed to the present writ petition within two weeks. Rejoinders thereto be filed within two weeks thereafter.
7. List on 20.08.2025.
