In the reply filed by the petitioner before the Tribunal, the petitioner stated in Paragraph 5 that the respondent had, specifically, opted out of the Pension Scheme introduced in 1992. It appears that a copy of the Option Form submitted by the respondent was placed as Annexure R2 before the Tribunal.

However, no Option Form has been placed on our record. Learned counsel for the petitioner has sought to place reliance on the photocopy of

the Service Book of the respondent, wherein a stamp has been put stating “not opted for pension”. It is not clear whether the respondent has signed the said endorsement after the same being made in the Service Book.

Counsel for the petitioner wishes to take instructions and to place on record the relevant documents. Let the same be placed on record along with an additional affidavit within a week.
