1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner praying for grant of the Senior Time Scale (in short, 'STS').
2. The respondents had rejected the said claim of petitioner stating that since there is no promotional rank in the hierarchy of the Ministerial Cadre beyond the post of Assistant Commandant (Ministerial) in the Border Security Force, the petitioners are not eligible for grant of STS.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has, *inter alia*, contended that in other Armed Forces, including CISF and CRPF, even when there was no promotional post beyond the Assistant Commandant (Ministerial), STS was being granted. He submits that, even otherwise, the very concept of STS is applicable to a case where there



is stagnation in a particular cadre.
