ORDER
21.08.2024

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1. Mr. ML Lahoty, the petitioner who appears in person submits that he has received the copy of the reply filed in his case. However, some of the petitioners raise grievance with respect to compliance of the order dated 16.05.2024. They submit that they have not received the copy of the counter affidavit which was directed to be supplied *vide* order dated 16.05.2024. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Council, however, disputes the said position.
2. Without going into the controversy as to in which writ petitions the copy of the counter affidavit has been supplied or otherwise, the Court directs learned counsel for the respondent-Council to furnish a copy of the counter affidavit filed in W.P.(C) 5260/2023 to all learned counsel for the writ petitioners during the course of the day.
3. The respondent-Council is also directed to file an affidavit of service of the counter affidavit by tomorrow.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners are also at liberty to file an application, within three working days, if the order passed today is not complied with.
5. Mr. Rajesh Srivastava, learned counsel who appears for one of the



writ petitioners is directed to furnish e-mail addresses of all the Counsel who are appearing in the respective writ petitions, during the course of the day to Ms. Pooja Kalra, learned counsel for the respondent-Council, failing which it shall be presumed that the counter affidavit is served upon all the writ petitioners.

6. The petitioners shall be at liberty to file the rejoinder affidavit within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the counter affidavit.
7. Learned counsel for the Intervener is at liberty to place on record the written submissions.
8. The respondent-L&DO is directed either to file a comprehensive counter affidavit dealing with the issues involved in all the writ petitions or to file a separate counter affidavit. Let the same be decided by the Competent Officer of the respondent-L&DO.
9. In any case, if the counter affidavit on behalf of respondent-L&DO is not placed on record within two weeks, the Court shall consider for direction of the personal appearance of the Senior Officer of the respondent-L&DO.
10. List on 19th November, 2024.
11. Interim orders to continue.
