For the reasons stated in the application, the delay in preferring the appeal is condoned. Application stands disposed off.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of the observations made in para 28 of the impugned judgment that the victim has not suffered any loss of income, the compensation under the head of loss of future income, was not sustainable. The only other challenge to the impugned Award is the grant of interest to the extent of 9% while awarding compensation.

On these two limited grounds issue notice on PF/RC to the respondent No.1 for 19.11.2019. Meantime, subject to deposit of 50% of the Award



amount within four weeks with the Tribunal, which shall be dispersed in consonance with the terms of the Award, the operation of the impugned Award is stayed.
