The Court would note that the previous order of this Court dated 21.11.2019 has not been complied with.

On 21.11.2019, the following order was passed:

“Compliance Report apropos this Court's order dated 24.10.2019 has not been filed. Mr. Jatinder Singh, the Assistant Manager of United India Insurance Company Limited, who had filed an affidavit in support the appeal, is present in Court. The learned counsel for the appellant, states upon instructions from Mr. Jitender Singh, that approval has been sought for monies to be expended for the aforesaid compliance and he seeks one last opportunity to comply with the Court's orders.

The learned counsel for the appellant and the Assistant Manager state that they are aware that the cost of each of such trees would ordinarily not exceed Rs. 300/- which they would procure and supply to the DCF (S) for plantation, in terms of the Court's order



dated 24.10.2019. The plantation shall be done by 07.12.2019.

The insurance company shall ensure that its Officer and/or the Assistant Manager is present at the site when the said plantation is carried out.

The Officer concerned shall be present in the Court on the next date.

List on 11.12.2019.”

There is clear breach of this Court's order despite the assurance of the Assistant Manager that compliance would be done.

Mr. Amit Kr. Singh, the learned counsel for the insurance company submits that on the previous date, Mr. Pankaj Prakash, Manager (Law), had appeared before this Court, however, his name could not be recorded. He is not present in Court today.

Issue notice to the said officer, returnable on 18.02.2020, as to why the proceedings of contempt be not initiated against him.
