1. File is placed before this Court vide order dated 09.07.2025 for recording the statement of the parties.
2. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 104/2023 of PS Jagatpuri for the offence under Section 354/506 IPC on the ground that he has compromised the dispute with the complainant de facto (respondent no. 2).
3. As per the submissions, the matter between the petitioner and R-2 has been amicably settled.
4. Vide separate statement recorded in this behalf, petitioner stated that dispute between him and R-2 has been amicably settled as per the settlement deed dated 10.12.2024. The settlement has been arrived at between the parties herein without any force, coercion, undue influence and pressure. He has signed the settlement deed with his wish and will. Vide separate statement recorded in this behalf, R-2 stated that dispute between R-2 and petitioner has been amicably settled as per the settlement deed dated 10.12.2024. The settlement has



been arrived at between the parties herein without any force, coercion, undue influence and pressure. The settlement deed has been signed with my wish and will.

5. Investigating Officer is present in Court and has duly verified the identity of both the parties. Separate statement of Investigating Officer has also been recorded.

6. The parties along with their counsels have confirmed that the settlement deed has been duly entered into between them.

7. The compromise/settlement deed is in writing and has been duly signed by both the parties. I have heard both the parties and from the direct dialogue with both the parties, it is observed that the consent of both the parties is found to be genuine and has not been obtained under undue influence or pressure.

8. Since statements of the parties have been recorded, matter be placed before the Hon'ble Court on 23.12.2025.
