The plaintiff has not taken requisite steps for filing Joint Schedule of the documents till date despite the order dated 14.08.2024. On the last date of hearing on the personal ground of learned counsel for the plaintiff, no adverse order was passed and last and final opportunity was granted to the plaintiff to file Joint Schedule of the documents in terms of the order dated 14.08.2024.

At this stage, it is stated by learned proxy counsel for the plaintiff that he has filed Joint Schedule of the documents yesterday but fails to disclose the diary number. It is stated by learned counsel for the defendant that he has not received any draft of Joint Schedule of the documents from the plaintiff till date and has neither provided any inputs or signed copy of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiffs.

Learned proxy counsel for the plaintiff is not able to explain that how Joint Schedule of the documents has been filed yesterday without sharing draft and obtaining the signatures of learned counsel for the defendants. It shows that the plaintiffs have not followed due procedure for



filing Joint Schedule of the documents and even filed the same highly belatedly. Accordingly, cost of Rs.5000/- is imposed upon the plaintiff to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee and the last and final opportunity is granted to the plaintiff to file Joint Schedule of the documents as per law within four weeks with copy to the opposite side.

The plaintiff is also directed to file hard copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record within three weeks as a last and final opportunity.

The defendants have not filed hard copy of the documents till date without furnishing any plausible explanation. So, cost of Rs.1000/- is imposed upon the defendants to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee and the last and final opportunity is granted to the defendants to file hard copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record within three weeks.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 14.05.2025.
