b) issue appropriate writ/order/directions in the nature of mandamus to direct the Respondents to forthwith release the arrears due to the Petitioners on account of such revision w.e.f. 01.01.2016 alongwith interest @9% from 01.01.2016 till the actual date of payment to the Petitioners;



c) pay costs- appeal/writ/order/directions in the nature of mandamus commanding the Respondents to pay the costs of this petition to the Petitioners;”

4. Issue notice.
5. Notice accepted by Mr. Shivendra Singh, learned counsel for respondent no.1 and Ms. Latika Choudhury, learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3.
6. Counter affidavit be filed within four weeks with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the respondent.
