Mr. Maninder Singh, learned counsel for the appellant has forwarded by e-mail a compliance report dated 02.07.2020 in the matter. Let the same be filed on record.

2. Mr. Singh states that in compliance of the last order, the NCB has handed-over to him the appellant's original expired passport, against receipt. Counsel has also received an authority letter and photographs from the appellant through the jail authorities. After exercising much effort, Mr. Singh has contacted the Nigerian High Commission; and has been advised that for obtaining a passport/travel document the appellant will have to be present in-person for obtaining his biometrics and digital photograph.

3. Mr. Rajesh Manchanda, learned counsel for NCB states that the NCB would have no objection if requisite directions are issued to facilitate issuance of passport/travel document by the High Commission.
4. Accordingly as suggested by Mr. Singh, the Jail Superintendent is directed to arrange for the appellant to be produced *in custody* before the concerned officer of the Nigerian High Commission on 08.07.2020 at 10.00 a.m., for purposes of taking the appellant's biometrics and digital photograph for issuance of passport/travel document.
5. Mr. Singh may coordinate the other logistics for processing the issuance of passport/travel document by the High Commission.
6. For reporting on completion of the aforesaid steps, list on 10th July 2020.
