I.A. 5307/2021 (under Section 151 of CPC, 1908- for exemption)

1. Subject to the plaintiff filing legible copies of any illegible documents on which he may seek to place reliance, within four weeks from today, exemption is granted for the present.

2. The application is disposed of.

I.A. 5306/2021 (under Order XXVI, Rule-9 & Order XXXIX, Rule-7, of CPC, 1908- for appointment of LC)

1. This application has become infructuous, as the Local Commissioner was appointed and the commission stands executed.

2. The application stands disposed of accordingly.

I.A. 5305/2021(under Order XI, Rule 1(4) read with Section 151 CPC, 1908 – regarding additional documents)

1. Mr. Pankaj Kumar, submits that he would file any additional



documents, as it may so choose with the replication, subject to the right of the defendants to admit or deny the same.

2. Accordingly, this application does not survive for consideration and is accordingly disposed of.
