1. By order dated 01st October, 2024, the Revenue Authorities were directed to conduct the exercise of demarcation of the 80 feet road on *Manohar Lal Khurana Marg in Kishan Ganj, Delhi*.
2. It is pointed out that a joint inspection was earlier carried out by the different departments, and it was submitted before this Court that demarcation of the land is required to be done by the Revenue Department.
3. It is the case on behalf of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (“MCD”) that despite various letters to the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (Revenue), Civil Lines as well as to District Magistrate (Central), no action with respect to demarcation has been taken up by the Revenue Department.
4. Today, learned counsel appearing for the Government of NCT of Delhi, submits that there has been a change in counsel and that his office has recently been engaged. He, thus, submits that he may be granted some time for filing a Report after requisite demarcation proceedings are carried out by the Revenue Department.
5. Considering the submissions made before this Court, it is directed that the demarcation of the area in question shall be carried out by the Revenue Department in the presence of all the authorities, who are parties before this Court, including, Railways, on 15th April, 2025 at 11:00 AM.
6. The Demarcation Report shall be filed by the Revenue Department along with the Joint Inspection Report, within a period of two weeks, after the joint inspection.
7. All the respective parties shall cooperate with the Revenue Authorities, in carrying out the demarcation of the area, and shall supply all the requisite records/information, that may be required, at the time of demarcation, by the Revenue Department.
