1. The petitioner seeks suspension of sentence during the pendency of the petition.
2. The revision petition is directed against the order dated 23.02.2021 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Saket Courts, New Delhi in FIR No.305/2010 convicting the petitioner for offences punishable under Sections 279/304A/471 IPC and Sections 185/146/196 M.V. Act, by which the petitioner has been sentenced to simple imprisonment for six months for offence under Section 279 IPC; for a period of one year and six months simple imprisonment and fine of Rs.5,000/- for offence under Section 304A



IPC; six months simple imprisonment for offence under Section 471 IPC; three months simple imprisonment and fine of Rs.2000/- for offence under Section 185 M.V. Act; and fine of Rs.1000/- for offences under Sections 146/196 M.V. Act. All the sentences are to run concurrently.

3. In view of the fact that there is no likelihood of the petition being heard within a period of six months, this Court is inclined to suspend the sentence of the appellant during the pendency of the petition.

4. The sentence of the petitioner is suspended and he is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, subject to the conditions that the petitioner will give his current local address to the local Police Station and shall keep the IO and the local Police Station informed in case of change of address.

5. The application stands disposed of.
