% **ORDER**
16.01.2025

1. The present appeal is filed challenging the award dated 31.10.2015, passed by the learned Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal-01, ('MACT') West, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi, in case no.350/2010.
2. It is undisputed that Respondent No.1 was entitled to receive compensation. The only dispute remaining to be adjudicated is in regard to the person who is responsible to pay the compensation.
3. The appellant claims that the driver of the offending vehicle was not holding a valid licence and therefore the right to



recovery should have been granted to the appellant.

4. Mr. Sameer Nandwani, Advocate for the appellant points that inadvertently 100% of the awarded amount has been deposited by the appellant.

5. The learned Trial Court is directed to release 50% of the deposited amount in favour of Respondent No.1 and the balance amount be released to the appellant.
