3. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking *inter alia* the following reliefs:-

“(i) issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the respondent No. 1/school to refix/revise the salary of the petitioner in terms of the recommendations of 7th Central Pay Commission w.e.f. 04.07.2017 (initial date of appointment of petitioner), as mandated under Section 10 of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973;

(ii) issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the respondents to pay the arrears of salary, as payable to the petitioner on account of revision of his salary in terms of Prayer No.(i), along with appropriate interest thereupon to be



calculated@ 18% per annum;

(iii) issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the respondent No. 3/DOE to take appropriate action against the respondent No. 1/school on account of violation of the provisions of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973 as well as the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973;

(iv) Allow the present writ petition with exemplary compensation, costs and litigation expenses in favour of the petitioner; and

(v) Pass any such other or further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and in favour of the petitioner”

4. Issue notice.
5. Notice is accepted by Ms. Latika Choudhury, learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.3.
6. Upon petitioner taking steps within a week, notices be served upon the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 by all permissible modes.
7. Counter affidavit, if any, be filed within four weeks from the date of service with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the respondents.
8. List on 25.07.2024 before the Registrar for completion of service as also pleadings.
