1. Application filed on behalf of the Respondent for release of the decretal amount, which has been deposited in the Court.
2. Learned Counsel for the Appellant opposes the application and states that though the decretal amount has been deposited pursuant to the outcome of this case, the same cannot be permitted to be released as the Appeal is yet to be heard on merit.
3. Considering the totality of circumstances, the Application is hereby dismissed.
