1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CRL.REV.P.(NI) 132/2026 & CRL.M.(BAIL) 810/2026 (suspension of sentence)

2. The revisionist was convicted under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act and was sentenced to payment of fine of Rs. 15,18,728/- within 90 days from 21.03.2023. The said order was upheld by the appellate court by way of impugned judgment dated 23.03.2026.

3. Since the appellate order was silent as regards to the period during which the fine amount had to be deposited, learned counsel for revisionist seeks one week to deposit with the Registrar General of this Court the entire fine amount (*after deducting the amount of Rs. 3,05,745/- which is stated to have already been deposited before the appellate court*). Subject to doing so, the revisionist be not arrested till next date. However, if the said amount is



not deposited within one week, the trial court shall initiate process to ensure that the revisionist faces the sentence.

4. Subject to revisionist taking steps within one week, notice through all modes be issued to the respondent, returnable on 01.10.2026 in Advance List.

5. The digitized record of the trial court be requisitioned.
