3. By virtue of the present petitions under *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (**BNSS**), petitioner seeks quashing/setting-aside of the impugned orders dated 13.04.2026 and 25.02.2026 in CRL.M.C. 2936/2026 and impugned orders dated 13.04.2026 and 12.03.2026 in CRL.M.C. 2937/2026, CRL.M.C. 2970/2026, CRL.M.C. 2971/2026, CRL.M.C. 2972/2026 respectively.

4. Issue notice.

5. Learned APP for the State accepts notice. She seeks, and is granted, time to file/handover Status Report *three days* prior to the next date of hearing/ on the same date.

6. Learned counsel for the parties seek, and are granted, a period of *four weeks* for filing their respective written synopsis afresh not exceeding *five pages*, giving a chronological list of dates and events and relevant documents, if any, alongwith duly highlighted judgments setting out the propositions of law therein, they wish to rely upon.

7. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner while addressing arguments, has provided brief details of the dispute(s) involved, particularly the involvement of the earlier FIR No. 285/2025 dated 12.06.2025 at PS: Zirakpur, Punjab which, according to him, is the very genesis of the dispute(s) involved. He further submits that pursuant to registration of the subsequent FIR No.322/2025 on 30.10.2025 at PS: Crime Branch, Chanakyapuri, there are other five i.e. FIR No.76/2025 dated 11.06.2025, FIR No.135/2025 dated 16.10.2025, FIR No.86/2025



dated 30.06.2025, FIR No.87/2025 dated 30.06.2025, and FIR No.134/2025 dated 16.10.2025, which have been registered at PS: Economic Offence Wing, respectively.

8. *De hors* the aforesaid, and after some arguments to show *bona fide* of the petitioner, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join and participate in the investigation if, as and when, called by the IO.

9. In response, the learned APP for the State, upon instructions from the IO present in Court, submits that the petitioner shall join and participate in the investigation on 27.04.2026 at 03:00PM.

10. As such, the petitioner is directed to join and participate in the investigation before IO on 27.04.2026 at 03:00PM.

11. Needless to say, the IO shall be free to summon the petitioner if, as and when required, and also call for the requisite details in the interregnum as well.

12. In the meanwhile, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner till the next date of hearing.

13. Renotify on 15.07.2026.

14. A copy of this order be kept with the connected matters.
