1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. This appeal is directed against the judgment and decree dated 15.01.2024 passed by the Family Court.

3. Via impugned judgment, the divorce petition filed by the appellant wife under Section 13(1)(ia) & (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been dismissed.

4. The record shows that the appellant/wife has been working with the Delhi Police since June, 2009.

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5. In so far as the respondent/ husband is concerned, he is working for the Central Reserved Police Force (CRPF).
6. The record also discloses that the couple entered into matrimony on 24.12.2003. The couple, from the wedlock, have a girl child who was born, according to the appellant/ wife, on 15.11.2005 and according to the respondent/ husband, on 15.11.2004.
7. The matter requires further examination.
8. Issue notice to the respondent *via* all permissible modes, including email.
9. List the matter on 20.08.2024.
10. Registry will summon the trial court record *albeit* in a digitized form and place the same on the Court record, prior to the next date of hearing.
