ORDER

12.12.2025

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1. The parties, along with their respective counsel, are present in the Court. The father of the Appellant and the mother of the Respondent are also present.
2. It is stated that the parties have mutually agreed that the Appellant shall pay a sum of Rs. 18,00,000/- to the Respondent, apart from returning her *Streedhan*, towards full and final settlement of all her claims. The parties have further agreed to dissolve their marriage as they have been unable to reside together due to temperamental differences.



3. Learned counsel for the parties jointly pray for some time to place on record a duly executed deed of settlement and to file a petition under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the learned Family Court seeking a decree of divorce by mutual consent.
