1. The application being CM APPL. 6238/2023 has been filed under Section 151 of the CPC on behalf of the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:-

"(i) Allow the present application and pass necessary directions directing the Respondents to approach the State Bank of India Industrial Finance Branch, Ground Floor, KRM Plaza, 2, Harrington Rd, Chetpet, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600031 to deposit the amounts under the Bank Guarantees stated in paragraph 2 with the Registrar General of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, New Delhi or in the alternative issue directions to the State Bank of India;



(ii) Any other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit to pass in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances. ”

2. This Court in terms of order dated 08.04.2019, has already directed for keeping the bank guarantees alive and *status-quo* is operating since then.
3. In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case, no further interim directions are required to be passed and instead, the matter deserves to be heard on an early date.
4. At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant application. The request is rejected.
5. The petition is *admitted*.
6. The interim order dated 08.04.2019, is extended till further orders.
7. List on 10.04.2023.
8. In the meantime, parties are directed to file their written synopsis and relevant judgments to be relied upon by them.
