Though the counter affidavit of the respondent no.3 submits that the Ministry of Coal has intimated to the respondent no.3 that the Ministry of Power, vide letter dated 01.05.2019, has agreed to the application of the petitioner relating to change in their plant capacity from 12 MV to 10 MV, the learned counsel for the respondent no.3 drawing reference to the Office Memorandum dated 01.05.2019 of the Ministry of Power, submits that this Memorandum in fact does not contain the said decision.

Though the learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that this would not make any difference to the merit of the petition, to get a clarity, the respondent no.1 is directed to obtain instructions on whether the Office Memorandum dated 01.05.2019 in fact recommends such reduction in the capacity or not.
