This petition has been filed by the Petitioner, who is the widow of Late Dr. Yograj Singh Yadava, a former Scientist with the Indian Council of Agricultural Research ("ICAR"), seeking a writ of mandamus for release of pensionary and other retiral benefits. It is stated that the deceased employee



superannuated on 31st March, 2015 after rendering more than 38 years of service; however, despite submission of service records and pension papers by the concerned office in August 2019, the pension and retiral dues were neither sanctioned during his lifetime nor released to the Petitioner after his demise on 30th July, 2023. The Petitioner claims that repeated representations, including a legal notice, have not elicited any response, and she continues to be deprived of family pension and other admissible benefits.

5. Issue notice to the Respondents, by all permissible modes, upon filing of process fee, returnable on the next date of hearing.
6. Renotify on 16th September, 2026.
