1. It appears that counter-affidavits filed by the DoE in W.P.(C) 3142/2020 and reply to CM APPL. No. 11404/2020 are still not on record. The DoE is directed positively to have the counter-affidavit and reply placed on record at least two days prior to the next date of hearing, failing which the Court would not advert to the said counter-affidavit.

2. Any written synopsis in these cases which is in excess of 5 pages, should be reduced to 5 pages and filed at least two days prior to the next date of hearing.

3. Renotify both these writ petitions on 22 February 2024 for hearing and disposal.

4. This is an application filed by the parents-association of the petitioner school seeking impleadment in the matter.

5. Mr. Jha, learned counsel for the association, has already drawn my attention to order dated 03 December 2021 which, in the concluding passage, states that the association would be heard when this matter is decided.
