ORDER

23.03.2026

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1. The matter is put on office note due to a typographical error in the Order dated 13.03.2026 in W.P.(C) 3142/2020. The corrected order shall read as under:

“W.P.(C) 3142/2020

1. Mr. Shashi Pratap Singh, learned counsel appearing for DOE requests for an accommodation to obtain instructions.

2. At this request, re-notify on 28.07.2026.”

2. Additionally, in the Order dated 13.03.2026 in W.P.(C) 3383/2020, apart from the order in the said writ petition, shall also include the order in the application being CM. APPL. 12002/2020. Thus the order dated 13.03.2026 in W.P.(C) 3383/2020 shall read as under:

“W.P.(C) 3383/2020

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:

“i. to pass an order directing the respondent schools to restrain them from collecting any unapproved fee from the director of education on the basis of any email communications from officials of Directorate of education and direct them to collect the fees as per the fees structure and refund or adjust the excess amount being charged to the parents from whom the hiked fees has been collected already after adjustment from the



officially approved fee structure i.e. fee structure for session 2016-17 for Saket Branch and fee structure for session 2017-18 for Sheikh Sarai Branch;

ii. to pass an order or direction to the respondent Delhi Police to investigate the complaints filed by respondent government against the respondent school regarding fraud, cheating and extortion from the amount collected by the school on the basis of emails purported to be addressed by the DOE Private School Branch to Mr Ish Bali.

iii. to pass any order or Direction to respondents to initiate the appropriate proceedings against the respondent School managements and the officers of Directorate of Education involved in the crime committed under appropriate provisions of Cr.P.C., IPC, IT Act, Disaster Management Act, Juvenile Justice Act, Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.

iv. Pass an appropriate order or direction for court monitored investigation of the the complaint filed against the school regarding fraud, cheating and extortion from the parents...”

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.

3. Mr. Yadav, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No. 7 to 9 and Mr. Jain learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No. 1 and 2. They seek and are granted time to file a reply before the next date of



hearing.

4. List on 28.07.2026.

CM APPL. 12001/2020

5. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC, 1908 seeking the following prayer:

“It is respectfully prayed from this Hon'ble court to pass an interim order directing the respondent school to update the dues of fees and arrears, as per the last approved fee structure of the school by Director of Education subject to final outcome of the present case or pass any other order or further orders this Hon'ble court deem fit on the basis of above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case.”

6. The issue with regards to the last approved fees structure by the Department of Education is still pending in W.P. (C) 3142/2020. Till the time, the same is not decided the present application shall not be maintainable and is accordingly dismissed.”
