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1. Issue Notice to the Respondents.
2. On behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 and 2, Ms. Harshita Nathrani, learned Counsel, has put in appearance and accepts Notice, whereas, Mr. Shighra Kumar, learned SPC, appears and accepts Notice on behalf of Respondent No. 3. Mr. Siddhant Nath, learned Standing Counsel, has put in appearance on behalf of Respondent No. 4 and accepts Notice. Ms. Kanika Agnihotri,



learned Standing Counsel, appears and accepts Notice on behalf of Respondent No. 5.

3. This Petition raises concerns about the inappropriate parking of seized vehicles, which is a common sight to the residents of Delhi. Because of inappropriate handling of such vehicles, sometimes, even the smooth transportation on the road, especially in front of Police Stations, becomes difficult. The Transport Department of Delhi Government has issued certain guidelines *vide* circular dated 20.02.2024, which has been enclosed with the Writ Petition as Annexure-P-3, however, it appears that on account of inadequate implementation of the said guidelines the situation has not improved.

4. Accordingly, let Affidavit(s) in Reply be filed by the Respondents giving details of the action taken for meeting the concerns expressed in the present Writ Petition.

5. We have been informed by the learned Counsel representing the Police Commissioner of Delhi that certain directions have been issued to all SHOs to appropriately handle the situation. The office of Police Commissioner of Delhi is directed to call for regular reports from the respective Police Stations in this regard. The Affidavit to be filed by the Police Commissioner of Delhi shall give details of such reports, which might be submitted by the SHOs of respective Police Stations.
