1. Learned counsel for respondent no.1/claimant submits that the claimant has received the entire awarded amount towards compensation from respondent no.2/insurer. He, therefore, prays that respondent no.1 be deleted from the array of parties.
2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 does not deny this position. Even otherwise a perusal of the appeal shows that the impugned award dated 28.07.2021 has been assailed only insofar as it grants recovery rights in favour of respondent no.2. In these circumstances, once respondent no.1 has received the entire compensation, there is no requirement of the said respondent to appear any further in the proceeding.
