c) Call for the records of the case;

2. Heard.

3. On filing PF within a week, issue notice to the respondent through all permissible modes, returnable before the Registrar on 6th August, 2024.

4. With regard to the prayer of the petitioner with respect to the interim relief, this Court is of the view that the instant matter requires consideration and, *prima facie*, the balance of convenience lies in favour of the petitioner. Therefore, the operation of the impugned orders dated 11th August, 2023, 12th December, 2023, 20th March, 2024, 21st March, 2024, 27th March, 2024 and 28th March, 2024 shall be kept in abeyance till the next date of hearing.
