1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 3164/2026 & CRL.M.A. 12815/2026 (*Stay*)

3. By virtue of the present petition under *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner seeks quashing of CC No.1862/2019 pending before the learned JMFC (NI Act), Patiala House Courts, New Delhi and all proceedings arising therefrom.
4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents accepts notice. At the outset, he submits that the present petition *per se* is not maintainable since the very same petitioner has also filed a revision petition challenging the order dated 27.03.2025 passed by the learned JMFC in the aforesaid case, which



is pending before the learned Sessions Court.

6. In response thereto, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the said order dated 27.03.2025 has not been challenged before this Court by way of the present petition, instead what is sought is quashing of the entire complaint itself. As such, pendency of the said revision petition before the learned Sessions Court is no bar against the present petition.

7. In any event, keeping in view the nature of the facts and disputes involved, the parties are hereby called upon to file their respective written synopsis instead of reply/ rejoinder not exceeding *five pages*, giving a chronological list of dates and events and relevant documents, if any, alongwith duly highlighted judgments setting out the propositions of law therein, they wish to rely upon at least *one week* prior to the next date of hearing. Written synopsis shall also include the assertions, if any, *qua* maintainability of the present petition.
