1. The instant petitions have been filed seeking the quashing of certain FIRs. Mrs. Jasmohinder Singh and Mrs. Manisha Sengar, Petitioners in CRL.M.C. 2265/2025 and CRL.M.C. 2278/2025, are implicated in two FIRs: FIR No. 231/2022 at P.S. Rajouri Garden and E-FIR No. 199/2021 at e-Police Station Lodhi Colony. They seek quashing of these FIRs based on a compromise with the Complainant/Respondent No. 2, as evidenced by the Settlement Agreement dated 25th March, 2025. Mr. Naveen Bhardwaj, Petitioner in CRL.M.C. 4363/2025 and also implicated in E-FIR No. 199/2021 at e-Police Station Lodhi Colony, seeks quashing of the FIR on merits, not pursuant to any compromise.
2. The Court is also apprised that Mr. Naveen Bhardwaj has filed another petition, CRL.M.C. 4372/2025, in which he seeks the quashing of FIR No. 231/2022, P.S. Rajouri Garden.
3. In light of the foregoing, the State is directed to submit a status report indicating whether the Prosecution's case against the parties not involved in



the settlement can continue independently, should quashing be allowed qua the Petitioners.

4. Re-notify on 9th September, 2025 along with CRL.M.C. 4372/2025.
5. In view of the Petitioners' advanced age as senior citizens, they are exempted from personal appearance and may participate in the proceedings on the next date *via* video conferencing.
