ORDER

1. Today in Court, defendants have brought a banker's cheque in the name of the plaintiff i.e. Castrol Limited dated 22.12.2025 for a sum of Rs.7 Lacs. Mr. Urfee Roomi, learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that the Castrol Limited is company incorporated in U.K. and does not have bank account in any India and, as such, the said banker's cheque cannot be encashed.
2. It is observed that the Apostilled Power of Attorney executed by the plaintiff in favour of Mr. Harshit Gupta, in para 2 permits Mr. Gupta to pay in or draw out of Court, any sums of money, which according to this Court, grants enough competence to Mr. Gupta to collect any monies which are deposited under the orders of this Court.
3. Accordingly, this Court requests Ms. Kaur, learned counsel appearing for the defendants to rectify the banker's cheque to the extent of name in whose favour it is drawn. The correct details shall be furnished by Mr. Roomi to Ms. Kaur during the course of the day.
4. Liberty to deposit or remit the said amount of Rs.7 Lacs to Mr. Harshit



Gupta by any other alternate mode, as mutually agreeable, is permitted.

5. Mr. Nareshbhai Babubhai Kanani is present in person. In view of the aforesaid order, the personal presence of Mr. Kanani is dispensed with.
