1. This is an Application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 under Rule 26 of the Delhi High Court Intellectual Property Rights Division Rules, 2022 on behalf of the Plaintiff seeking transfer of Rectification Petition No. 282026 pending before the Trade Mark Registry, Delhi to this Court and consolidate the same with the present Suit.
