1. By this application appellant seeks interim suspension of sentence on the ground that he has to appear for 2nd Semester B.A. LLB examination. Date sheet and admit card of the appellant filed along with the application which have been verified.
2. As per the nominal roll of the appellant is not involved in any other case and in the present case also he was convicted vide the judgment dated 28th April, 2022. During the pendency of the trial from the year 2009 till 2022, the appellant was on interim bail.
3. Considering the facts verified this Court deems it fit to grant interim suspension of sentence. It is, therefore, directed that the sentence of the



appellant be suspended for a period of 2 weeks from the date of his release upon his furnishing a Personal Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties in the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Central Jail and further subject to the condition that in the personal bond, the appellant shall provide the mobile number which he shall be using during the period of interim suspension of sentence so that he can be contacted as and when required.

4. Application is disposed of.

6. Copy of order be communicated to the Superintendent, Central Jail and a copy be given to the learned counsel for the appellant under signatures of the Court Master.
