**CRL.M.(BAIL) 563/2026 (for suspension of sentence)**

1. The appellant seeks suspension of sentence for a period starting from 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2026 to 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 in order to enable him to prepare and appear for his Second Semester Exams for B.A.(Pvt.) Yearly (Art Group).
2. It is submitted that appellant is pursuing B.A.(Pvt.) Yearly (Art Group) Programme from Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut, U.P, and his Second Semester Exams are to commence from



23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2026 to 06<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 at Baghpat, U.P as per the following schedule:

3. The learned APP has handed over the verification report, which confirms that the appellant is a student of S.P.S. College of Education, Baraut (Baghpat), U.P. The examination schedule has been duly verified.



4. The appellant was earlier granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 on the same ground.

5. Admittedly, the appellant has duly complied with the conditions of bail and did not misuse the liberty granted to him.

6. Keeping in view the examination schedule of the appellant, it is directed that the appellant shall be released on interim suspension of sentence/bail for a period mentioned here-in-below on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Jail Superintendent/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:

(a) The appellant shall be released on interim bail for a period from 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2026 to 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2026 and he shall surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2026;

(b) Thereafter, the appellant shall be released on interim bail for a period from 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 to 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2026, on the same bonds/sureties, and he shall surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2026;

(c) The appellant shall be released on interim bail for the period from 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 to 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2026, on the same bonds/sureties, and he shall surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent on 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

(d) The appellant shall appear in examination on the scheduled dates as noted in para 2 above, and shall leave the territory of Delhi only for the specific purpose of



appearing in the examinations at the aforesaid Centre at Baghpat, U.P. during the period of his interim suspension of sentence.

(e) The appellant shall under no circumstances leave India without prior permission of this Court;

(f) The appellant shall not directly or indirectly try to contact, threaten or intimidate any person connected with this case.

(g) The appellant shall provide his mobile number to the concerned Jail Superintendent, and shall keep the same operational at all times.

(h) The appellant shall not commit any offence whatsoever during the period he is on interim bail.

7. The application, accordingly, stands disposed of.

8. A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for compliance.
