**REVIEW PET. 256/2024 & CM APPL. 37450/2024 (condonation
of delay of 51 days in filing review petition)**

1. By this review petition, the review petitioner seeks a review of order dated 8 April 2024 to the extent it dismisses CM Appl. 51796/2023.

2. Mr. Parvinder Chauhan, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the review petitioner points out that there are specific allegations against his client in the writ petition and that therefore, his client is a necessary party.



3. The Court has seen the paragraphs of the writ petition to which Mr. Chauhan has drawn our attention. It is correct that there are specific allegations of misdemeanour, etc. against the respondent.
4. Mr. Lakhota, learned counsel for the petitioner, is not in a position off hand to state that his client would not be pressing the said allegations.
5. Accordingly, the applicant is entitled to be impleaded as a party in WP(C) 4192/2020.
6. We, therefore, recall order dated 8 April 2024 in so far as it dismisses CM Appl. 51796/2023.
7. This Court does not make any comment on the contents of the application or its correctness. This Court is allowing the review applicant to be impleaded only because there are specific allegations against him in the writ petition.
8. Accordingly, the Review Petition is allowed. The review petitioner is permitted to be added as a party respondent. Let an amended memo of parties be placed on record by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
9. The application is disposed of.
