Matter is taken up through physical hearing as well as video conferencing.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the judgement debtor that in terms of Supreme Court's order, the possession of the suit property has been handed over to the decree holder.

However, on the other hand, learned counsel for the decree holder submits that though they have been handed over the possession of the second floor by the judgement debtor but there is no independent separate entry leading to the second floor, and on the main gate, a guard deputed by the JD is there, who restricts their entry. DH requests for grant of keys of the main gate as well as of the entry leading to the second floor.
