ORDER

1. On hearing learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties, it seems that the judgment-debtor has certain objections against the compromise decree.
2. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the judgment-debtor submits that such a decree ought not to have been passed, keeping in mind various pre-existing circumstances.
3. Though the said prayer is strongly opposed on behalf of decree-holder, however, in the interest of justice, the Court grants time to judgment-



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debtor to place on record an appropriate application duly supported by way of an affidavit.

4. Let the same be done within seven working days from today.
5. On receipt of the objections to be filed by the judgment-debtor, the decree-holder shall be at liberty to file the reply within two weeks thereafter.
6. List on 01.05.2025.
