1. Learned counsel for the defendants has handed over a physical copy of the bank statement of defendant nos. 1 and 2 to the learned counsel for the plaintiff. He states that the bank's statements will be e-filed within a period of one (1) week. He states that the list of infringing listings which were handed over to defendant no. 2 on the last date of hearing have been taken down. He states that he has been recently engaged and seeks a further one (1) weeks' time to file reply to I.A. 15305/2025.

2. This Court notes that a last opportunity to file reply at request of defendant no. 2 was already granted on 17.09.2025. However, since this is



an Order XXXIX Rule 2A application which entails penal consequences, further one (1) week's time is granted subject to the defendant nos. 1 and 2 paying costs of Rs. 10,000/- to the plaintiff within two (2) weeks.

4. Defendant no. 2 is directed to remain present in Court on the next date of hearing at **2:30 P.M.**
