1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rule 2A of the CPC, 1908 read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Section 151 of the CPC, 1908 arising out of the disobedience of orders dated 09.04.2025 and 21.04.2025.
2. Learned counsel for the defendant states that the reply has been filed last evening; however the costs have been handed over during the course of the hearing today. The delay in filing the reply is hereby condoned.
3. Plaintiff is directed to file its rejoinder within four (4) weeks.
4. The plaintiff is also at liberty to examine the bank account statements handed over by defendant nos. 1 and 2 on the last date of hearing and to make an assessment of the turnover of the defendant nos. 1 and 2.
5. Learned counsel for the plaintiff states that defendant be directed to file



the Chartered Accountant certificate making a full disclosure of the sales of the products under the trademark 'KRYTOX' and 'CHEMOURS'. He states that in case the defendant does not provide the Chartered Accountant certificate, the plaintiff would have to presume that the entire credit entries in the bank account is towards the sale of these goods.

6. Learned counsel for the defendant states on instructions from the defendant that the turnover for F.Y. 2024-25 was approximately Rs. 4 crores.

7. He states that a Chartered Accountant certificate will be filed placing on record the turnover of the products for the trademarks 'KRYTOX' and 'CHEMOURS' for the last two financial years.

8. Let the Chartered Accountant certificate be filed within a period of three (3) weeks.
