ORDER

1. Counsel for the parties submit that in the mediation proceedings before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre ('Mediation Centre') a settlement has been arrived between **(i)** Plaintiff and Defendant No.2 **(ii)** Plaintiff and Defendant No.5.
2. The settlement agreement dated 15th July, 2024, between the Plaintiff and Defendant No.2 has been placed on record.
 - 2.1 The said agreement bears the signatures of the authorized representatives of the Plaintiff as well as Defendant No.2.
3. The settlement agreement dated 15th July, 2024, between the Plaintiff



and Defendant No.5 has been placed on record.

3.1 The said agreement bears the signatures of the authorized representatives of the Plaintiff as well as Defendant No.5.

4. I have gone through the terms of both the aforesaid settlement agreements and do not find anything unlawful therein.

5. Parties shall remain bound by the terms of the respective settlement agreement.

6. Accordingly, the suit is decreed in terms of the aforesaid settlement agreements *qua* Defendant No.2 and Defendant No.5.

7. Let two separate decree sheets be passed in the suit *qua* Defendant No.2 and Defendant No.5.

7.1 The respective settlement agreement shall form part of the decree.

8. To be noted, the suit shall proceed against the remaining defendants.

9. List before the Joint Registrar on 04th December, 2024.

10. Since the matter has been settled between the plaintiff and defendant No.2, this application does not survive any further.

11. Accordingly, the application is closed.

I.A. 242/2024 (Order I Rule 10(2) on behalf of defendant No.5)

12. Since the matter has been settled between the plaintiff and defendant No.5, this application does not survive any further.

13. Accordingly, the application is closed.
