1. This RFA was admitted for hearing and directed to be listed in 'Regular Matters' as per its own turn vide order dated 4.9.2017.
2. It is not possible to hear final arguments of Regular Matters of RFAs in the Admission Board. Early hearing is not possible in this matter of the year 2017 because there are hundreds of matters of previous years whose litigants are silently waiting for their turn to be heard in queue. There is no reason why later cases be given preference over earlier cases, except in

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grave and very urgent circumstances.

3. After change of the Roster all the RFAs which were earlier listed before three Courts have been brought together in this Roster to be decided by this Bench. It is, therefore, not possible as per the Roster of this Bench to hear final arguments of Regular Matters in the Admission Board.
