1. Present application has been filed under Section 151 Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (hereinafter referred as 'CPC') seeking stay of operation of the impugned order/judgment dated 22.07.2022 in FA No.244/2018 passed by learned Delhi State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission.
2. Learned counsel submits that a recovery certificate has been issued by Assistant Collector GR-II, Sub-Division (Chanakyapuri), District, New Delhi directing the petitioner herein to deposit the entire award amount i.e. Rs.15,00,000/- along with interest @ 9% per annum from 01.10.2012 till the actual realization of payment and also a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- as cost and Rs.50,000/- as cost of litigation in favour of the respondent.
3. None has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent despite



service of advance notice.

4. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner be allowed to deposit the said amount before the District Forum i.e. District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission-VI, New Delhi and not directly to be paid to the respondent pending the present petition.

5. The amount as per recovery certificate be deposited with the District Forum in FDR in auto renewal mode within one week.

6. In view of above, application stands disposed of.
