2. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 67/2022 of PS Bhalswa Dairy for offence under Section 363/366/376 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act. The quashing is sought on the ground that the complainant *de facto* (respondent no.2) and the prosecutrix (respondent no.3) have compromised the disputes with petitioner.

3. Respondents no.2 and 3 identified by IO/SI Divya are present in court. Statements of parties have already been recorded by the Joint



Registrar.

4. It appears that initially respondent no.2 had lodged missing complaint pertaining to her daughter respondent no.3, aged few days less than 18 years. The respondent no.3 got married with the petitioner and now they have two infant children.

5. After going through the marriage documents, learned APP for State suggests and rightly so that in order to ensure welfare of respondent no.3 as well as two infants, it would be necessary that first they get their marriage registered. Learned counsel for petitioner seeks time to do so.
