I.A. 9713/2025 (for exemption)

1. The instant application is filed seeking exemption from filing dim/legible copy of annexures.
2. It is to be noted in umpteen number of cases exemptions are granted subject to the condition that fair and legible copies of annexures be filed. However, the parties concerned frequently fail to comply with this requirement within the stipulated timeframe. This non-compliance results in significant delays and causes considerable inconvenience to the Court, disrupting the orderly progress of proceedings and thereby impeding the timely resolution of cases.
3. Furthermore, in certain cases, it has been brought to the Court's attention that the parties have undertaken before the concerned Registrar not



to rely on illegible documents. However, when the matter is listed before the Court, despite such undertakings, these very illegible documents are relied upon.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the Court directs that the plaintiff shall file a fair, typed copy of dim/illlegible annexures immediately after the illegible copy of the same annexures before the next date of hearing.

5. The Registry is directed to verify the aforesaid aspect and, thereafter, list the matter before the Court on 22.04.2025. If compliance is not made, let a specific note be appended in the office noting.
