I.A. 9859/2025 (Condonation of delay)

1. Having heard learned counsel for the plaintiff, and for the reasons stated in the application, the same stands allowed. The delay of two (2) days in curing the defects stands condoned.
2. The application stands disposed of.

I.A. 9713/2025 (for exemption)

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff submits that in terms of earlier directions, she has filed the documents by way of Index-IV. According to her, the earlier documents which were filed along with the Index-IV can be completely ignored.
2. The Registry is directed to delete the earlier Index-IV and the documents filed along with the same.
3. Henceforth, only the re-filed Index-IV shall be taken into



consideration for all practical purposes.

4. The application stands disposed of.

CS(COMM) 344/2025

1. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons be issued to the defendants by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two weeks.

2. Summons shall state that the written statement(s) shall be filed by the Defendants within 30 days from the date of receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file affidavit(s) of admission/denial of the documents of the Plaintiff, without which the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record

3. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication(s) within 15 days of the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replication(s), if any, filed by the plaintiff, affidavit(s) of admission/denial of documents of the defendants, be filed by the plaintiff, without which the replication(s) shall not be taken on record. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.

4. It is made clear that any party unjustifiably denying documents would be liable to be burdened with costs.

5. List before the concerned Joint Registrar for further proceedings on 22.05.2025.

6. Thereafter, list before this Court on the date to be given by the concerned Joint Registrar.
