ORDER

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17.04.2025

1. We have heard Mr. Abhay Kumar Bhargava, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Rishabh Sahu, learned Senior Panel Counsel for the respondents for some time.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that he has been allotted a posting station other than the stations which were opted by him while exercising his option for posting.

3. Mr. Rishabh Sahu submits, on instructions, from Mr. Ajay Pal, Law Officer for the respondents that the vacancies in all 16 stations for which options have been submitted by the petitioner stand exhausted. He submits that the respondents have proceeded strictly in accordance with the sliding scale of entitlement for postings as to be



seen at page 38-39 of the paper book.

4. He also points out that it is for this reason that the petitioner has, in his prayer clause, included a prayer for being allowed to exercise fresh choices of posting.

5. The prayer for being allowed to exercise fresh choices of posting, in our view, cannot be granted at all.

6. However, as Mr. Bhargava disputes the contention of Mr. Rishabh Sahu that all vacancies at the choices of posting given by his client stand exhausted, we direct Mr. Rishabh Sahu to place the details in that regard on record by way of an affidavit within a period of two weeks with an advance copy to Mr. Bhargava, who may file response thereto, if any, within one week.

7. We make it clear that we have not passed any interim order in this case.

8. Re-notify on 13 May 2025.
